### Meeting Minutes: May 9, 2018

#### In Attendance:

Rae Ann Shoemaker called the meeting to order.

Bob Mowery made a motion to approve the April 11th minutes. The motion was seconded by Dave Matlock. All approved.

#### Future Planning:

John Shelton spoke to the Board about coming up with some possible projects for the next capital improvement tax. The main project on John's wish list was a new aquatic center. He also listed new lights on Atchley ballfields, a splash pad at Harke Park, a new park office, a soccer field complex developed at Atchley Park, and walking/bike trails. City Administrator Michael Schumacher said the tax will go to the voters in November for renewal. Rae Ann Shoemaker stated that a conceptual drawing of the aquatic center and its features would be a great thing to show the citizens. John asked the Board to come up with other projects they would like to see, and the Board can discuss at the next meeting.

#### Baseball/Softball Leagues and Tournaments:

Elliot Wilburn reported that the past weekend they hosted a baseball tournament at Atchley Park and a softball tournament at Nelson Park. He also said that 3 other weekend tournaments have already been scheduled in the next month and that all youth leagues will be in full swing by May 14<sup>th</sup>.

#### Citizen Concern- WT Vernon Park:

John reported that a citizen had called him about concerns of children playing basketball in the street near WT Vernon park and asked about the possibility of a basketball court being installed there. John thought that it was something we should look into when work begins on the land across from WT Vernon Park. He said right now he doesn't know of anyway to prevent kids from playing basketball in the street.

#### Certified Youth Sports Administrator

John congratulated Elliot Wilburn on getting his certification as a Certified Youth Sports Administrator through the National Alliance for Youth Sports. John explained that Elliot attended a class while at the MPRA conference and then had to do some online training and pass 9 different tests to complete the certification. He said that this training should be a huge help with the parks starting to run the youth softball and t ball leagues.


