## Home Energy Audit Rebate Program

Even small leaks will reduce your home's energy efficiency. The U.S. Department of Energy says reducing drafts in the home can bring potential energy savings of 5 to 30 percent. In addition to the savings, your home will feel more comfortable after you've stopped the heat loss.

Saving on home energy expenses is a widespread goal, but what's the secret when energy costs keep skyrocketing? Do the next best thing; request a home energy audit to tame those out-of-control high energy bills. Doing what you can before another winter season of heat escapes from your home is critical to putting an end to runaway utility bills.

A home energy audit will help you determine exactly how much energy your home consumes, discover the areas where heat is escaping and show you ways to conserve hot water and electricity.

### ***Receive up to \$100 in credit rebates applied to your next utility bill***

Lebanon residential and small commercial utility customers will receive a \$50.00 rebate credit, applied toward their utility bill, upon completion of an initial home energy audit.

During the audit, a blower door test will be performed to pinpoint leaks. A performance evaluation of the ductwork is conducted. Insulation levels are checked and the efficiency of your heating and cooling system is accessed. The qualified auditor will leave you with a detailed report outlining cost-effective measures that will reduce energy costs specific to your home.

Use this report to make corrective actions and then call to schedule a one-time retest. A

final re-test is performed to verify proper installation of recommended improvements. If the test proves satisfactory, a second rebate of \$50.00 will be applied toward the customer's utility bill.



## **Guidelines**

- Rebates are available to Lebanon residential utility customers and businesses in the “small commercial” electric rating category, and who are customers of record for active non-delinquent accounts.
- This service must be performed by a qualified energy auditor/HVAC contractor registered with the City of Lebanon.
- Copies of auditors invoice(s) and detailed report(s) must be submitted after each audit/test, to the address indicated below, prior to receiving rebate credit(s). Failure to provide required information may result in denial of rebate.
- Rebate will not exceed the cost of services performed and/or will not exceed the rebate mentioned.
- Rebates are limited to one per residential or small commercial customers during each program year beginning in November.
- Rebates are awarded on a first-come, first-serve basis until program funds have been depleted.
- City of Lebanon reserves the right to inspect any site in question, to verify a successful audit is complete and corrective actions have been taken, prior to receiving rebate. Should this program be abused by the customer and/or contractor, the City of Lebanon reserves the right to charge the cost of this rebate back to the customer’s utility account.
- City of Lebanon is not responsible for the heating/cooling systems performance or energy savings, and does not provide any warranties or guarantees, expressed or implied.
- City of Lebanon reserves the right to amend or discontinue this program without notice.
