CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
April 12, 2021

BE IT REMEMBERED that the Council of the City of Lebanon, Missouri, met in Regular Session on April 12, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall located at 401 South Jefferson.

ROLL CALL AND DECLARATION OF A QUORUM

Upon roll call, the following Officers were present: Gib Adkins, Ken Eldridge, Sheila Mitchell, Jonathan Reagan, Randy Wall, Chuck Jordan, Bob Garner, and Mayor Carr. Absent: Josh Ray.

A quorum was declared.

Staff members and others in attendance: City Administrator Mike Schumacher, Public Works Director Richard Shockley, Police Chief Bryan Arnold, Electric Superintendent Travis Long, Environmental Services Superintendent Eric Mork, Code Administrator Joe Berkich, Public Works Analyst Kelly Roberts, Purchasing Agent Jessica Meiners, Communications Manager Derek Gean, Assistance City Administrator/City Clerk Laina Starnes, and City Counselor Chris Allen.

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Invocation was given by Don Anderson of Union Mission Church, followed by the pledge of allegiance.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Melissa Price- tattoo artist from Studio Ink expressed her concerns with kids getting tattoos in unsafe places because current City Code prohibited minors from getting them from professional establishments within the City. She also communicated that some were even going to other communities that allowed minors to get tattoos with parental or guardian consent, which resulted in a loss of revenue for local establishments. She closed by saying she was in favor of repealing the code related to tattoo parlors.

Jason Parker- owner of Studio Ink, reiterated Ms. Price's previous comments. He stressed that safety was important but also said that allowing artists to administer tattoos to minors would benefit his business.

During this time, questions were posed by several Councilmembers and personal thoughts were expressed about minors getting tattoos with parental or guardian consent.

DISCUSSIONS AND PRESENTATIONS

Lineman Appreciation Day Proclamation

Mayor Carr read the following proclamation aloud and proclaimed April 12, 2021 "Linemen Appreciation Day".

WHEREAS, City of Lebanon Utilities is a valuable community asset that contributes to the well-being of local citizens through customer service, environmental protection, economic development, safety awareness, and energy efficiency; and

WHEREAS, Lebanon's lineworkers have a deep commitment to our community often going beyond keeping the lights on; and

WHEREAS, Lebanon's lineworkers are our community's first-responders in the wake of power outages caused by major winter and summer storms and other catastrophic events, working to make the scene safe for other public safety personnel; and

WHEREAS, the work of Lebanon's lineworkers not only includes providing reliable power for our own community, but also responding generously to assist in staffing needs for neighboring cities and states; and

WHEREAS, the second Monday of April is designated in state law as an annual observance of Missouri Lineworker Appreciation Day by the people of Missouri;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT PROCLAIMED, by the Mayor of the City of Lebanon that we express our heartfelt appreciation to all who so diligently serve to ensure that electrical power continues to flow to the homes and businesses of this city; and

BE IT FURTHER PROCLAIMED, that I declare April 12, 2021, as "Lebanon Lineworker Appreciation Day;" and

BE IT FURTHER PROCLAIMED, that all citizens take time to reflect on the benefits they receive from the dedicated service of the City's lineworkers and that they take all opportunities to express appropriate appreciation to these public servants; and

BE IT FINALLY PROCLAIMED, that the City Clerk is hereby instructed to prepare suitably inscribed copies of this Proclamation and provide them to those so employed by the city.

An Ordinance by the City Council of the City of Lebanon, Laclede County, Missouri, (hereinafter referred to as "City") amending the City Code of Ordinances Chapter 24 Taxation, Article III Taxation and Regulation of Occupations and Franchises, by repealing Division 3 Tattoo Parlors, in its entirety.

Public Works Director Richard Shockley- presented the required "Annual Report on Net Metering Customers" as required by state statute. During this time, he reported the City had 9 solar customers with a total generation of 38,476 kWh and a capacity factor of 5.6%

Councilman Jordan- shared he finally got away on a vacation and it felt good to be out and about.

Councilman Wall- said he had recently attended the PBR Bull Riding event at the Cowan Civic Center and expressed he felt the City had a great facility that a lot of other communities didn't have.

Councilman Reagan- congratulated Councilman Eldridge on his reelection to City Council.

Councilwoman Mitchell- congratulated Councilman Eldridge on his reelection to City Council. She also expressed she thought this was a good meeting and liked it when there was productive discussion like the one this evening regarding tattoo parlor regulations.

Councilman Eldridge- thanked Studio Ink employees for their comments related to tattoo parlors and to the voters for their support in reelecting him to the City Council.

Councilman Adkins- reported he was recently in the company of some Kansas City residents who was bragging on the Lebanon community.

Mayor Carr- provided the upcoming meeting schedule and then stated he was looking forward to another great year. During this time, he commended the City Council and City staff.
