BE IT REMEMBERED that the Airport Advisory Board of the City of Lebanon, Missouri, met on April 15, 2024, at 6:00 p.m. at the Floyd W. Jones Airport FBO Building, 2407 S. Jefferson.

ROLL CALL AND DECLARATION OF A QUORUM

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Files moved and Jordan seconded to approve the March 4, 2024, meeting minutes. Motion passed unanimously.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

Weekend and Holiday Avgas Full Service Refueling

Mike Wood discussed that each time fuel was required on a weekend or holiday, it would be handled on a case-by-case basis but that each employee was instructed to always be courteous and civil toward all customers. If the request for fuel was a larger amount, full-service fuel would be more favorable than a smaller amount of fuel, due to costs of fuel.

Hanger Lease Notification

Mike Wood reported that sometime before the end of the current ground lease contracts, the City would reach out to the tenants of self-owned hangers) with an optional lease choice to be explained at that time. City-owned hanger tenants would be reminded of some of the requirements that are in the currently executed contracts that each has signed in the past.

Oshkosh Dates

OSHKOSH dates were discussed in order to work out the special and advertising dates. The dates will be July 22<sup>nd</sup> through July 28<sup>th</sup>.


BOARD COMMENTS
