Meeting Minutes: May 11th, 2022

In Attendance:

RaeAnn Shoemaker called the meeting to order.

Jacob Hedges made a motion to approve the April 13th minutes. The motion was seconded by Dave Matlock. All approved.

Big Bam Event:

Lindsey Slavens reported to the Board that the Big Bam event would be stopping and the riders camping at Boswell Park on June 14th. She said that around 200 riders would be there and that they would be passing out beer samples to each rider. The riders would be allowed a maximum of 3 beers, and they would all be inside an enclosed roped off area when consuming the alcohol. She said no beer would be sold or given to the public just the signed in riders of the event.

Baseball/Softball League Update:

Elliot Wilburn reported that Spring competitive leagues will finish next week and that summer leagues start on May 23rd and will be played on Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday nights. There is also a tournament scheduled this weekend that has 50 teams registered and there are additional tournaments scheduled every weekend until July 2nd.

Boswell Aquatic Center Update:

John Shelton reported that Chad Coleman the current pool manager has taken a job in Bolivar that will begin after the pool season and that we would likely need to find a new manager for next season. Chad will continue in his role this year throughout the summer. He also reported that all lifeguard positions have been filled and that the pool will be opening on Tuesday May 31st.

Skatepark Grand Opening

John stated that after ball season ends, he would like to have a grand opening for the skatepark. He is working with a sponsor to donate hot dogs and sodas for the event. He also said with the popularity of the skatepark that he would like to see about adding a bowl to the skatepark concept. This addition would likely cost around \$75,000.

There were no comments from the Board.


Comments from the Public:
