Fiscal Year 2025 Budget

Finance Director Kat Gill gave an overview of the budget review process for FY25 and stated the three priorities of the budget remained addressing traffic flow, improving code enforcement, and stormwater management as identified by our citizens. She then reported on revenues and expenditures and then gave budget highlights which included projects, capital investment, and proposed fee schedules for Code Administration as well as utilities. During her presentation, Gill stated the City overall was in a healthy financial position.

Expansion of the Lebanon Special Business District

Downtown Executive Director Sarah Stewart provided the proposed expansion areas that property owners have requested to be included in the district. She stated this public hearing was the first of two required hearings as required by state statute and advised that the next public hearing would be held on June 10th along with the ordinance to approve the expansion.

Rezone of 756 N Adams Avenue from RS-2 Residential to C-1 Commercial

COUNCIL BILL NO. 6671- AMENDING CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES CHAPTER 6 ANIMALS TO ADDRESS CHICKENS

An Ordinance by the City Council of the City of Lebanon, Laclede County, Missouri, (hereinafter referred to as "City") amending the City Code of Ordinances Chapter 6 Animals to address Chickens within the City.

Jordan moved and Garner seconded that the Council approve the second and final reading of Council Bill No. 6671 and that the roll be called for the approval and passage of said bill.

Mutchler moved and Mitchell seconded that Bill No. 6671 be amended as follows. Stricken language is reflected in red strikethrough and added language is reflected in bold. The graph is also part of the amendment.

Sec. 6-21. Number of animals; residential restriction

- (b) ~~A maximum of six chicken hens is permitted on a person's property.~~ **Six chicken hens are allowed for lots 5,000 square feet or greater. An additional hen is allowed for each 2,500 additional lot square footage to a maximum number of twenty (20) hens.**

The following table provides more information regarding the number of chickens allowed per property.

5,000 (min.)	6
15,000	10
27,500	15
40,000	20 (max.)

Sec. 6-33. Chicken Coop Regulations.

- (b) **No person shall keep chickens in any pen having an area of less than 144 square feet or the exterior boundary of which is less than 50 feet at the nearest point from the dwelling of another, a church, a school or a place of business of another.**
- (c) **If more than 12 chickens are kept in a pen, the pen must have an area equal to 12 square feet for each additional chicken in such pen.**
- (d) **No person shall keep more than 12 chickens in any pen the exterior boundary of which is less than 100 feet at the nearest point from the dwelling of another, a church, a school or a place of business of another.**
- (e) **Chicken coops shall not be attached to the main building.**
- (f) **Chicken coops shall have gutters and downspouts, 4:12 sloped roofs. Proper water drainage and management to eliminate standing water.**
- (i) **Chicken coops shall have cross ventilation and use hardware cloth to cover ventilation openings. Ventilation openings shall have regular maintenance to prevent dust build-up and vegetation growth near ventilation openings. Adequate ventilation will reduce moisture buildup.**
- (j) The floors of every chicken coop shall be a minimum of one foot off the ground, smooth, tight, **resistant to moisture**, and maintained so as to prevent accumulation of filth or water or harboring of vermin thereunder.
- (m) **Chicken coops shall have adequate roosting bars and nesting boxes in ratio to amount of hens broods.**
- (n) **The chicken environment shall have adequate shade at all times in the year.**

An Ordinance by the City Council of the City of Lebanon, Laclede County, Missouri, amending the City of Lebanon, Missouri, zoning district map by approving the rezoning of 756 N Adams Avenue from RS-2 Residential to C-1 Commercial; fixing the effective date thereof; repealing ordinances or parts thereof in conflict.
