Staff Reports

Public Works Director Richard Shockley advised the Board that there were several broad band providers interested in expanding into Lebanon.

Electric Superintendent Travis Long shared the Electric Department had installed a couple of air brakes at Feeders 50 and 60. He also announced that they had ran fiber to the Robert W. Plaster Center for Student Success and that tree trimming was still in operations.

Environmental Superintendent Eric Mork shared that the Environmental Department was almost completed with the Lake Regional sewer system and they have moved to Legacy Trails to start the construction of that sewer system. Mork then presented a presentation to the Board which included the history of the Wastewater Treatment Plant, along with the updates that have occurred over the past several years.

Eric Mork took the Board on a tour of the plant, where he introduced the equipment and explained the functionality of the equipment.
